

Assignment 8: Animated Flash Banner included in 2nd version of your website project

Due: April 21

Create an animated banner in Flash CS3 for your website final project.



The banner will be positioned at the TOP of your website page, and should be displayed on EVERY PAGE of your web site for consistency with the look and feel of your website. You may need to update and change the design of your first draft webpage in order to incorporate the addition of a banner onto your existing pages.

Directions:

Create a new Document in Flash CS3 . Set the sizing of the banner to 720 x 100 pixels.

Immediately Save the banner as a .FLA file in your EXISITING web site project folder, located on your external USB hard drive. (You will import the banner into Dreamweaver, once it is inside of your folder and it has been published.)

Add Text and other design elements, such as logo, cartoon or other picture into your banner into frame 1 on the timeline.

Animate at least one or more elements on your banner, using Motion or Shape Tweens as demonstrated in class. Consider making the text fly by, adding a little cartoon creature, your own logo or other ideas.

Once you have created a banner that you are happy with, be sure to save the .FLA file again. When you are finished animated, it is time to Publish your banner and create the animated .SWF movie. To do this, go to the FILE> Publish button, and click publish. This should create an SWF and an HTML file in the SAME Folder as your existing website project.

Once you have created the Banner's .SWF file, it is time to place it into your website. Open up the pages of your website on which you plan to place the banner in Dreamweaver. Go to the INSERT MEDIA button (which is to the right of the INSERT IMAGE tree button.) select Flash, than navigate to the FLASH .swf banner in your folder and select it. Update all of your web pages to include this banner. Web pages can also contain variations on your original banner, as long as the visual "look" of the banner is consistent with the other pages. Add in any other flash elements to the second version of your website.

Burn your entire Web site folder, (with the functioning added Flash animated banner incorporated onto your website)- onto a new CD and turn in a clearly labeled CD inside of jewelcase. Fill out the Grading Name form, and update the storyboard of your web page design and enclose it into the front of the Jewelcase. Turn in the jewelcase containing the second version of your website with the flash banner now included, **for a progress grade on April 21.**

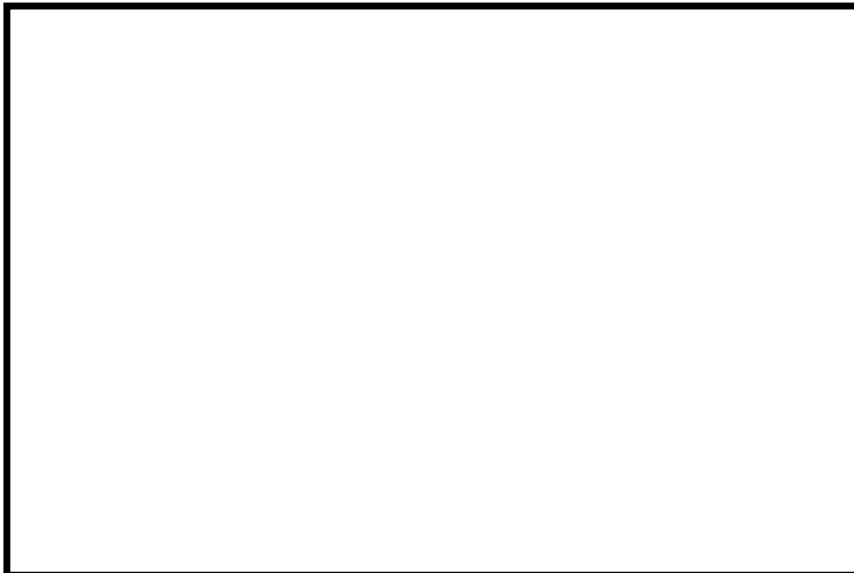
